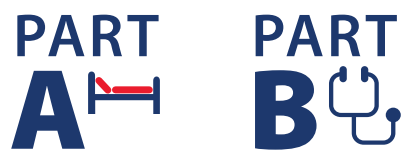


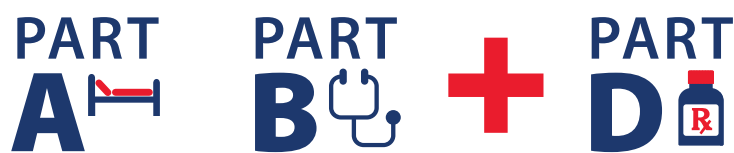
Seven combos to choose from

There are seven different combinations of plans to choose from.

1. Original Medicare (Part A and/or Part B) alone



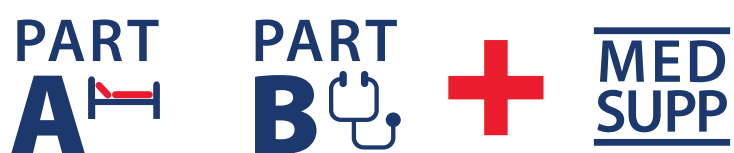
2. Original Medicare (Part A and/or Part B)
PLUS a standalone Medicare Part D Prescription Drug plan (Part D)



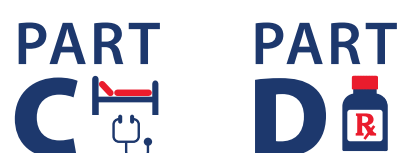
3. Original Medicare (Part A and/or Part B)
PLUS a standalone Medicare Part D Prescription Drug plan (Part D)
PLUS a Medicare Supplement (Medigap) insurance plan



4. Original Medicare (Part A and/or Part B)
PLUS a Medicare Supplement (Medigap) insurance plan



5. Medicare Advantage plan (Part C) that includes Medicare Part D Prescription Drug coverage (Part D)



6. Medicare Advantage plan (Part C) without Medicare Part D Prescription Drug coverage (Part D)



7. Medicare Advantage Private Fee-for-Service plan without Medicare Part D Prescription Drug coverage (Part C)
OR a Medicare Savings Account (MSA) plan
PLUS a standalone Medicare Part D Prescription Drug plan (Part D)
